Job Definition Summary

Promote and support the health and welfare of the school community by:

I. The provision of first aid, nursing care, health advice and student developmental

monitoring

- 3. Promote and assist in the maintenance of a healthy, safe and energetic community.

Responsibility

All duties should be carried out in a professional, caring and safe manner. Confidentiality

should be maintained unless circumstances indicate otherwise.

I. The provision of first aid, nursing care, health advice and student developmental monitoring

• Promptly attend to students, staff and visitors who become ill or injured while on-campus or during an off –campus activity

- Follow up on ill or injured students and staff
- Provide on going nursing care to students who are ill or require support due to an injury
- Keep your first aid skills, clinical assessment and management skills updated and relevant
- Promptly arrange for further medical or psychological attention when circumstances indicate.

• Provide parents/guardians and relevant school staff with information about student health or developmental concerns and give advice if applicable in a timely manner

• Maintain accurate and updated health and screening records

• Keep updated on local and global health issues relevant to the school's welfare and provide information to the school community where applicable

• Provide annual student developmental health screening

The provision of health education

• Initiate health education programs through classroom activities, assemblies, talks, displays, promotion of health awareness days/activities

• Provide support and involvement with the Life Skills (PSHE and SEAL) curriculum in areas relevant to health

• Provide support with the academic curriculum in areas relevant to health

Promote and assist in the maintenance of a healthy, safe and energetic community

• Promote and assist in maintaining infection control procedures including procedures for identified communicable diseases

• Monitor and maintain the safety and cleanliness of the Medical Room facility and equipment including daily checking of the AED(automated external defibrillator)

• Report and follow up maintenance and cleanliness issues promptly

• Maintain, audit and store medical supplies and equipment according to manufacturer and local authority guidelines

- Dispense and store medications according to Ministry of Health regulations for nurses
- Audit and maintain outlying first aid equipment eg first aid kits at least each term
- Provide students and staff with basic emergency first aid knowledge and skills
- Assist in the recording, follow up and storage of Incident and Injury data
- Assist in creating school policy and procedure relevant to health and welfare
- · Communicate effectively about health and welfare issues with parents and school staff
- Maintain strong links with outside medical and health agencies
- Promote and role model a personal healthy lifestyle
- Be actively involved in the school life

Requirement:

- The applicants must be registered with the Malaysian Nursing Board;
- Have a minimum of 2 years clinical experience;
- A good knowledge of written and spoken English and be IT literate.;
- Some experience in school nursing would be an advantage but not essential.
