Listening & Speaking

Fun activities such as spelling games, public speaking, philosophy discussions, and effective communication games that are geared towards enhancing the abilities of the students to be able to grasp how the English language sounds when it comes to the phonetics of different words, and being able to ensure that students are able to overcome their fears of trying to speak in a language that they are yet to master.

Comprehensive Reading

Building reading habits from an early age is important, but many young students find it difficult. We have put together a comprehensive reading programme that is light, and fun to ensure students are able to maintain focus and enjoy reading English texts, and books.

Creative & Academic Writing

University applications and English exams always require either a creative or academic writing that students will need to brush up on. Easy essays, postcards, letters, and story-writing will allow students to be able to grasp what is to be expected of them when applying for universities or sitting for examinations.
