## Additional to School Uniform Requirements

Notebooks and folders for storing class notes, dividers and plastic wallets.
Pencil case (clear ones advised for examination years)
Stationery - Ruler, Eraser, Sharpener, Scissors, pens, pencils, highlighters,
Maths Set including compass, protector and set square, and calculator
Language dictionary (if necessary)

Pupils are encouraged to make their rooms feel homely. Therefore it is possible to bring soft furnishings, posters and pictures to decorate their areas. Pupils will also have regular shopping visits and items for rooms can be purchased on these trips. There will also be opportunities to purchase additional stationary, clothing and toiletries as necessary.

Money can be stored with a pupil's HMM for additional purchases.

Pupils are able to bring electronic devices to College. They should be labelled clearly. Teachers share work online and pupils require the ability to access these documents. A laptop is the best route to achieve this (device usage is carefully controlled).
