GOOD MANNERS


Everyone should be treated with courtesy and respect. By being mindful of the needs of others, we all benefit from the positive culture that ensues.

INTRODUCTION

Epsom's British Summer School is known to be one of the most prestigious and immersive experiences for students wanting to explore Malaysia, make new friends, and step outside of their comfort zone - all while harnessing high quality English classes offered by internationally trained teachers specialising in primary and secondary school teaching.

In 2022, Epsom boasted a 300 participant attendance, recognised as one of the largest summer camps to be held in the region. Participants will be fully immersed in a robust programme that will allow them to experience Epsom's curriculum, which is based on close to 200 years of academic excellence of our sister school, Epsom College in the UK.

A fully residential programme, Epsom's British Summer School Camp blends dedicated English classroom sessions delivered by skilled native English language teachers. It covers fundamental speaking, listening, reading and writing skills through interactive activities, creative assignments, and fun-filled competitions with classmates from a wide range of cultural backgrounds and ethnicities in a safe and controlled environment. Epsom's British Summer School Camp is also pleased to introduce a new dedicated classroom session for accent training as part of the programme.

A full roster of sports, music and drama, social and cultural activities as well as excursions to exciting locations around Malaysia, is integrated into the English learning experience. This programme is perfect for those who are excited to improve their mastery of the English language in a condensed period of time whilst sharpening their life skills and forging life-long memories.

WHO IS THIS PROGRAMME FOR?

Epsom's British Summer School Camp is designed for students between the ages of 8 to 16 who already have a good command of the English language but are looking to reach the next level in their English proficiency. Students wanting to explore Malaysia independently are welcome to participate in this programme as there will be many opportunities for this.

PROGRAMME - DETAILS -

English Mastery Classes

A series of interactive lessons centred around the usage of the English Language to provide the students with a fun way to learn more about the language. This session is the fundamental building block of the summer school curriculum, and aims to give students a classroom setting that is familiar while distinguishing the strengths and weaknesses of each student. These classes take place in the mornings from 9:00am - 11:00am, and 11:30am - 12:30pm on all days except for Wednesdays and Sundays.

Exploratory Afternoons

Here is a sample of the fun activities that were undertaken in the previous edition for the exploratory afternoon sessions - students typically do these within their classroom groups but outside of their classrooms.

ARTS & CRAFTS	You will be exploring different forms of art, and you will have to be creative in this session.
STEM ACTIVITIES	This session will give students the opportunity to use the English language in Science, Technology, Engineering and Maths areas. Students are expected to present their work at the end of the session/get involved in a Q&A session.
SINGING	Using songs and music as a medium for teaching English. Activities such as creating lyrics from popular songs will allow students to be creative and build confidence through songwriting/singing. Students will be given an opportunity to memorise a popular song and/or perform their own songs in small groups in class.
FUN ENGLISH ACTIVITIES	This session aims to develop students' interest in learning the target language through a variety of fun activities such as action songs, treasure hunts, role plays, crossword puzzles, show & tell and many more. It emphasises the joy of learning and indirectlyand allows pupils to explore how English is used in different ways.

ENGLISH READING

To develop reading for pleasure, comprehension, vocabulary and fluency with a range of material suitable for language level. The sessions will take place initially in the classroom and then the library.

PERFORMANCE POETRY

This session will allow learners to engage with the language in terms of diction. By responding to poetry, learners will bring the poems to life and experiment with a variety of words verbally and in written form.

SINGING/DEBATING

Either using pop music to improve language levels (comprehension, vocabulary, discussion, grammar points), or debating to construct an argument, persuade others, and defend your stance.

BOARD GAMES

Students are introduced to basic moves and specific language, vocabulary, used in games such as Chess, Snakes and Ladders, and Ludo. For students who are interested in learning how to play Chess I can also teach them the basic moves.

STORY TELLING

Afternoon activities will be based on stories - role playing, Interactive storytelling, writing creative stories, making masks and puppets. Creating costumes of a fairy tale character using newspaper and recycled items for a fashion show.

FUN ACTIVITIES & GAMES

Playing board games eg: monopoly, charades, hangman and learning through music and role play

SCIENCE EXPERIMENTS

A series of fun science experiments

LET'S GET PHYSICAL

The lesson will be focused around teaching the kids the importance of having an active life and eating healthy. The time will be split into two parts where students learn the concepts of healthy eating and the second will be focused on home exercises and a classroom game of choice. This will take place in the classroom. Vocabulary and grammar will vary depending on the group.

MUSIC

Poetry - teaching the children about beat and rhythm within poetry and using the beat of a drum when reading poems out loud. This lesson will take place in the music room.

AWESOME EVENINGS

730-9pm - available on all days except Wednesdays and Sundays

PUBLIC SPEAKING PROGRAMMES

Working with experienced teachers on improving their spoken English along with their ability to explain things in a clear manner. Increase inner confidence, enunciation, clarity and passion for our future leaders.

MUSIC & DRAMA

A dedicated session with a closing finale with up to 500 seats to fill in Epsom's theatre - music & drama evenings are meant to invigorate the passion to perform, plan, sing, act, and entertain amongst students.

COOKING CLASSES

Have you always wanted to try your hand at making a dish that you enjoy a lot? In this session, students are exposed to a variety of different cuisines while learning a myriad of different techniques and preparation methods for hot foods, breakfast items and pastries. This programme is beginner friendly and welcoming to all ages.

ROBOTICS

This dedicated session focuses on crafting and creativity skills.

Hands-on coding, building, and designing skills are a core component that will be continuously developed while bringing out the best of each student's talents.

HIP HOP & SPANISH DANCE

Get active! From Krumping to pop and locks to Salsa and Flamenco, the dance classes are specially curated to learn on the movements and improve on coordination. Students will take in new choreographies to bring new dance moves for their next birthday party.

ADVENTUROUS MEDIA CLUB

The media club analyses books, tv shows and movies. The students will do a deep dive in understanding roles of characters, historical background, or even pop culture references. It is a fully supervised 90-minutes, with properly rated contents. This helps to engage deeper with stories and foster critical thinking within students.

E-SPORTS

Always a fan of mobile and computer games? This session aims to provide students with a theoretical and strategic guided class to improve on technique while better understanding the games that are played. A get together of e-Sports enthusiasts to learn and play some of the more popular games. Create new bonds and friendships to survive the game. A mini competition to be held to crown reigning champions by the end camp.

ELITE BADMINTON

Serve, lob, drop, drive, and smash.
Professionally managed sessions with a dedicated coach available to assist students with improving their badminton skills. Students will undergo intensive 90 minutes of training with a tournament during their final week to help improve comradery, all while having some fun.

ART & DESIGN

Students will undergo a variety of different projects throughout the entire summer school - this evening activity is dedicated for students who have a passion for creating art and a strong desire to unleash their creativity. Epsom's art & design studio provides a luxurious experience with an expansive inventory that will allow students a space to craft to their hearts desire.
