- Epsom has 3 terms in a year, which starts from September to July.
- All international students are required by the Malaysian authorities to have a Student Visa (with a validity of 1 year) prior to arrival. Epsom will process these student visas for a fee of USD625 for new applications and USD250 for subsequent visa renewals. For both new applications and renewals of Guardian/Dependent visas, USD250 will be charged.
- A fee of USD750 per term will be levied on EAL programmes (only for students who require EAL support).
- In select instances, Year 5 and Year 6 students may be considered for the Full Boarding Programme.



### Application Fee

- Application Fee is payable alongside submission of the Application Form. This includes the cost of the Entrance Test.
- The Fee is payable by cash, credit card, bank transfer or cheque (made payable to Epsom College Malaysia Sdn Bhd).

### Enrolment Fee

- The applicant's place in Epsom is confirmed once the School is in receipt of the duly signed Letter of Acceptance and Enrolment Fee.

### Refundable Deposit

- A Refundable Deposit as indicated in the table overleaf, is payable together with the term's Tuition & Boarding Fees when a student is enrolled.
- The Refundable Deposit shall be topped up where applicable to ensure that the Refundable Deposit is in line with the relevant Year Group.
- Failure to provide a full term's notice will result in the Refundable Deposit being forfeited.

### Tuition & Boarding Fees

- Tuition & Boarding Fees are payable before the start of each term.
- Tuition & Boarding Fees cover:
  - Three (3) main meals; breakfast, lunch, dinner
  - Textbooks (On loan. Damaged textbooks will be charged accordingly)
  - Weekends Activities / Excursions
  - Laundry services
  - Co-Curricular Activities
  - Exercise books

### Note

- There will be additional charges for external examination, trips, additional sports coaching fees, private music lessons, transportation and uniforms.
- There will be additional charges for Exeat and Holiday Care for students who wish to remain in the School during term breaks or public holidays.
