- Epsom has three (3) terms in an academic year, which runs from August to June.
- Weekday Boarding encapsulates students residency at the school from Monday to Friday during term time. Full Boarding add-on (Friday evening through Sunday during term time) is available for an additional fee of only SGD5,000 per year.
- All international students are required by the Malaysian authorities to have a valid Student Visa prior to arrival. Epsom will process the student visas (with a validity of 1 year) in the following fees:
 - New application: SGD850
 - Renewal: SGD350
 - Guardian/Dependent visa (new/renewal): SGD350
- A fee of SGD1,000 per term will be levied for TEAL and SGD2,000 for IEAL programmes (only for students who require EAL support).
- In select instances, Year 5 and Year 6 students may be considered for the Weekday Boarding Programme.

Application Fee

- The Application Fee is payable alongside the submission of the Application Form. This includes the cost of the Entrance Test.
- The Fee is payable by cash, credit card, bank transfer, Flywire, or cheque. (Made payable to Epsom College Malaysia Sdn Bhd).

Enrolment Fee

- The applicant's place in Epsom is confirmed once the College is in receipt of the duly signed Letter of Acceptance and Enrolment Fee.
- The enrolment process - including the sharing of onboarding information such as boarding item lists and visa documentation - will only commence once the Enrolment Fee has been received and cleared.

Refundable Deposit

- A Refundable Deposit as indicated in the table overleaf, is payable together with the term's Tuition Fee when a student is enrolled.
- The Refundable Deposit shall be topped up where applicable to ensure that the Refundable Deposit is in line with the relevant Year Group.
- The Refundable Deposit is refunded upon providing a full term's notice of withdrawal in writing or the student's graduation after Year 13 from Epsom.
- Failure to provide a full term's notice will result in the Refundable Deposit being forfeited.

Tuition & Boarding Fees

- Tuition & Boarding Fees are payable before the start of each term.
- Tuition & Boarding Fees cover:
 - Three (3) main meals; breakfast, lunch, dinner
 - Co-Curricular Activities (excluding paid programmes)
 - Textbooks (On loan. Damaged textbooks will be charged accordingly)
 - Exercise books
 - Weekend activities
 - Laundry services
- Early payment discount of 5% is applicable for the lump sum payment of a full academic year's fee.
- Sibling discounts are applicable on tuition fees, for children attending the College simultaneously - 5% for the 2nd child and 10% for the 3rd child onwards.

Tuition & Boarding Fees do **NOT** cover:

- **Laundry Labels** (one-time upon enrolment): SGD80 will be levied for the laundry labels and will be charged with the first invoice

Note

- There will be additional charges for external examinations, trips, additional sports coaching fees, private music lessons, transportation, uniforms and Student Planner (for Year 7-9: SGD8 per year).
- There will be an additional Exeat Retainer fee of SGD300 per academic year (charged upon the first exeat night). For students who wish to remain in the school during weekends, term breaks or public holidays, Exeat and Holiday Care will be charged at SGD60 per night.
