FROM THE UK TO MALAYSIA

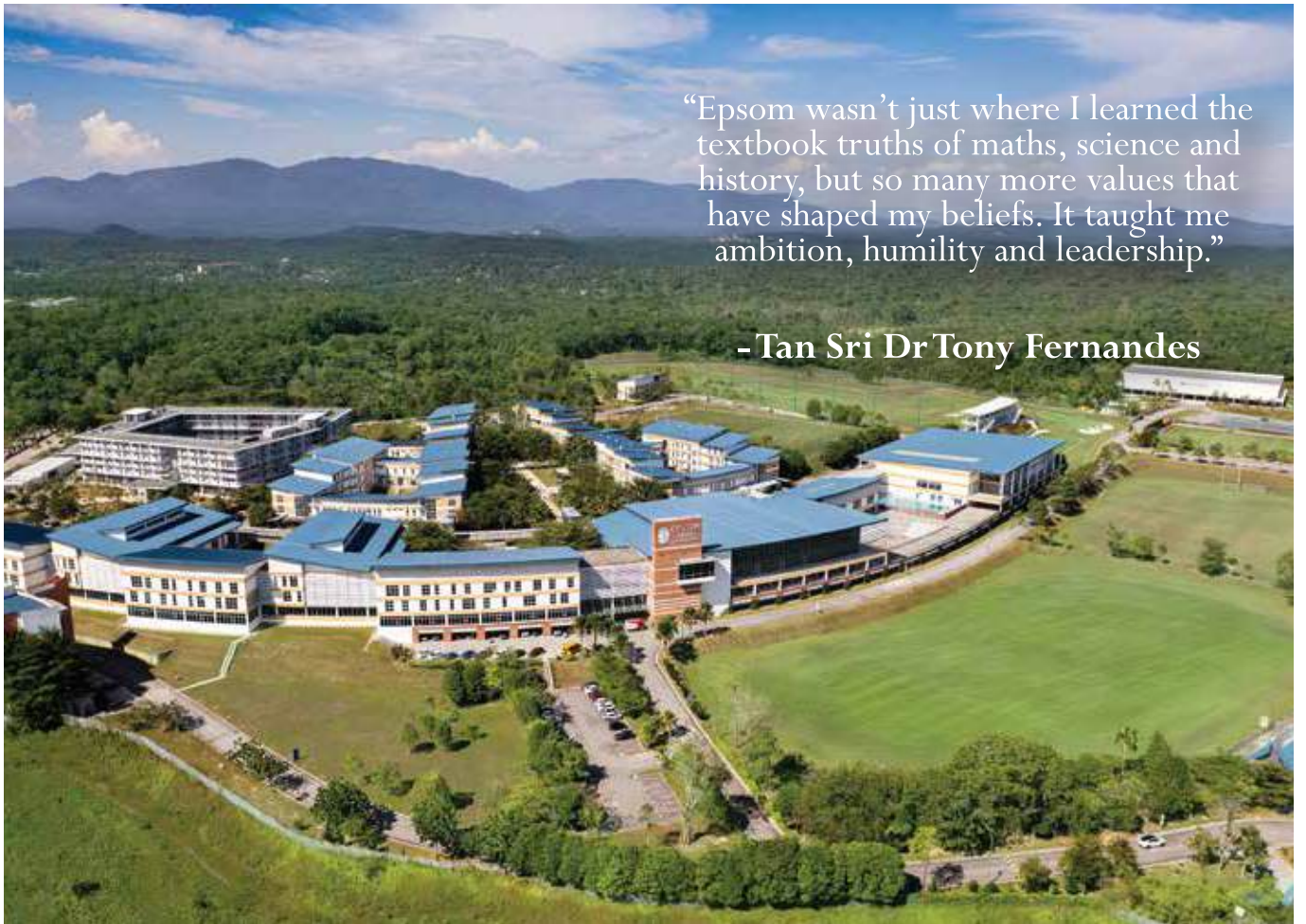

Award Winning Pastoral Care

At Epsom, pastoral care means more than just support - it means building character, fostering empathy, and ensuring that no child is ever left behind. It means family.

Epsom College Malaysia is **one of only six schools** worldwide to be awarded Double Beacon Status by **COBIS** (Council of British International Schools), out of more than 450 member schools globally.

The prestigious Double Beacons were awarded for **Student Welfare** and **Leadership in the School**. These recognitions affirm our deep commitment to nurturing student wellbeing, enriching leadership opportunities, and fostering a strong pastoral ethos where every student is seen, supported, and celebrated.

THE TUTOR SYSTEM

At the heart of our pastoral provision is the Tutor System. Each student is placed into a tutor group and sees their tutor almost every day. Tutors build positive relationships with their tutees, offering academic guidance and pastoral support while getting to know each child as an individual. This daily contact ensures that tutors can provide encouragement, monitor progress, and intervene early if challenges arise.

For our youngest learners in the Prep School, this same ethos of individual care is embedded through their class teachers and teaching assistants,

supported by multiple subject specialists. This structure ensures that each child has dedicated adults who know them well, while benefiting from specialist expertise that enriches their learning and development.

Uniquely, Epsom benefits from both a vertical system through the Houses - which fosters belonging across age groups - and a horizontal system through tutor groups, which provides age-specific care. This dual structure ensures that every child feels both part of a family and part of a peer group, with consistent, personalised guidance at every stage of their journey.



THE HOUSE SYSTEM

Every student - whether day or boarding - belongs to a House. A House is more than a building: it is a family, a home, and a source of pride. Students develop loyalty and belonging that lasts long after they leave Epsom.

In the Prep School, our dedicated Prep House system introduces children to this spirit of community from the very start. Through its vertically integrated structure, students form close bonds across year groups, creating a warm environment where younger learners build confidence, friendships, and values that prepare them for the transition into Senior School.

House life is enriched by a calendar of competitions and events, from sport to music, debating to drama, chess to mathematics. These activities are more than contests: they are opportunities to build confidence, teamwork, resilience, and camaraderie, preparing students to be well-rounded individuals who take pride in their House and in their school.

Positive Wellbeing

Our approach to wellbeing focuses on prevention rather than cure, helping your child make the right choices for a happier, more fulfilled life.

The focus of wellbeing within schools has been the support available should something go wrong. Of course, it is vital that the best possible support is in place, but we want to give every child the best chance to avoid ever needing that level of support or intervention.

We call it 'Positive Wellbeing' - an approach that develops good decision making, resilience, emotional intelligence, and peer support.

The aim is to support your child in making the right choices, choices that will help them to avoid some of the potential traps that lie in wait during the teenage years. And if they do occasionally make mistakes, we want to have helped them develop their character so that they can face adversity with strength, resilience, and positivity.

We include wellbeing in all aspects of your child's education and co-curricular activities. Students gain the tools to deal with challenges as and when they arise, and we encourage them to become cheerleaders for themselves and their peers.

CHARACTER EDUCATION

An integral part of wellbeing is our focus on **Character Education**, embedded within the PSHE (Personal, Social, Health, and Economic education) curriculum and across the wider school.

We aim not only to maximise exam results, but also to prepare students for successful, happy, and meaningful lives.

To do this, we help students to develop:

- **Intellectual virtues:** autonomy, curiosity, critical thinking, reflection, resourcefulness.
- **Moral virtues:** honesty, integrity, compassion, gratitude, humility, respect, justice.
- **Civic virtues:** citizenship, community awareness, service, volunteering, global responsibility.
- **Performance virtues:** resilience, confidence, motivation, leadership, teamwork, determination.

This structured, values-led education ensures our students grow into principled, thoughtful leaders.



A POSITIVE ENVIRONMENT

At Epsom, education extends far beyond the classroom. With over 150 co-curricular activities, clubs, and societies every term, students are encouraged to explore new interests, take risks, and discover their passions.

Teachers and coaches are trained to safeguard and support, spotting early warning signs and stepping in with positive, targeted help when needed. What makes Epsom unique is that the same teacher who explains quadratic equations in the morning might be coaching football or leading a music rehearsal in the afternoon. This means staff see students in multiple contexts, building deeper relationships and supporting them in a truly holistic way.

The extended Epsom day and breadth of curriculum allow us to understand each student as a whole person, helping them to flourish in and out of the classroom.

WHOLE-SCHOOL SUPPORT

Pastoral care at Epsom is a whole-school responsibility. Every adult – from teachers to matrons, librarians to grounds staff – plays a role in ensuring the safety, wellbeing, and growth of our students.

Daily care comes through a network of Housemasters, Housemistresses, matrons, and tutors. In the Prep School, pastoral care is more intimate still, led directly by the Head of Prep and Deputy Head, who ensure every child receives individual attention within a nurturing, small-school environment. Across the Senior School, Heads of Key Stage oversee both academic progress and personal development, supported by a dedicated Pastoral and Safeguarding Team.

If additional support is ever needed, our in-house counsellor and external specialists provide professional expertise, ensuring that students always have access to the care they require.

At Epsom, no child is ever left behind or left unknown. We take the time to understand each student's strengths, learning styles, challenges and successes. If your child stumbles, literally or figuratively, Epsom is there to lift them up.

Outstanding Results

An Epsom education is a springboard to incredible things. Inside and outside the classroom, we guide, support and encourage students to discover new ideas, hidden talents and untold opportunities.

Over the last 12 years in Malaysia, we have overseen a steady rise in academic standards at Epsom. The focus has been to build a supportive culture that celebrates ambition and success. Students are given opportunities to try new things, push new thinking and learn the art of failing well. We aim to encourage all our students to aim high, find joy in learning, and see that real 'outstanding results' are rarely just about exam grades.

Endless Opportunities

The benefit of a boarding environment, in 50 acres of private grounds, is that Epsom can offer so much more than top grades alone. Our expansive co-curricular programme offers endless opportunities for our students, preparing them for their future within and beyond Epsom.

CLUBS AND ACTIVITIES

Each week, students can choose from over 150 co-curricular clubs and activities, led by professional coaches and dedicated staff. Whether it's gardening, pottery, dance or astronomy, there's something for everyone, and every day of the week is packed with opportunity.

At Epsom, we don't believe in putting students into boxes or asking them to do so themselves. That's why our programme offers a mix of free-choice clubs and a carousel of rotating experiences, encouraging students to discover new interests and skills.

In various year groups, students step into leadership roles, mentoring younger peers, directing drama productions or leading academic societies.

If a student's passion isn't yet represented, they're empowered to launch their own society. Recent student-led initiatives include Medical Review Society, Business & Economics Society, Culture Society, Humanities Society, Arts Society and Film Society, Debating Society and many more.

Many of our clubs also provide the chance to shine on a larger stage, with participation in national and international competitions, including the Math Olympiads, World Scholars' Cup, Round Square and the Duke of Edinburgh's International Award.

ON-STAGE AND BEHIND THE SCENES

Four impressive large-scale productions are performed each year - with professional lighting, sets and sound.

In recent years, **Aladdin**, **Oliver! Jr.**, **We Will Rock You**, and **Mamma Mia!** have entertained sell-out crowds.

Whether centre-stage, backstage or in the pit, all students can get involved - last year, over 100 students helped make our shows spectacular.



MUSICAL EXCELLENCE

Music is central to the all-round ethos of the College and large numbers of students are involved in music each week. Elite choirs and ensembles represent Epsom at venues across Malaysia and overseas.

Our Prep School students benefit from compulsory music lessons, with a choice among violin, cello, flute, and saxophone. Prep School co-curricular activities offerings include choir, orchestra, and many more.

With nearly 200 students across both year groups, the Sixth Form offers a dynamic yet close-knit community.

Most students study three A-Level subjects, though some may opt for four.

We offer 21 subjects at A-Level. As part of our A-Level pathway, students may choose subjects that include BTEC qualifications, offering a more applied, coursework-focused learning experience with reduced emphasis on final examinations, alongside the opportunity to pursue IB Diploma courses through the International Baccalaureate Career-related Programme. OUTSIDE THE CLASSROOM

All students have the opportunity to lead a lively intellectual life outside of the classroom. Everyone takes an option from our Core Curriculum, which includes the Extended Project Qualification (EPQ), English, Core Maths, and the International Certificate for Digital Literacy.

Supporting Every Child's Journey to Success

At Epsom, we believe that every child is unique, with their own strengths, interests and aspirations. Our admissions process is designed to be thoughtful, personalised and stress-free for both the child and their family. It reflects our commitment to understanding each applicant as an individual and ensuring they are set up for success from the very beginning.

We aim to place every student in the right environment, one that challenges, supports and inspires them to thrive. Admissions at Epsom is not simply a matter of acceptance. EYFS TO YEAR 3 (AGES 3 TO 7)

At this early stage, we focus on potential, curiosity and enthusiasm. We want every child to feel welcome, confident and excited to learn. Our process is warm, gentle and designed to help us understand how a child will thrive within our learning community.

Admissions Process

- **Application:** Families share details about the child's background, interests, and personality
- **Interview:** Shortlisted applicants are invited for a friendly meeting with leaders of the Prep School
- **Engagement:** Depending on age and readiness, children may be invited to spend time at Epsom, engaging with teachers and peers in a safe, supportive environment

YEAR 4 TO YEAR 12 (AGES 8 TO 17)

From Year 4 onwards, students are assessed using a consistent and comprehensive process that helps us understand their academic ability, readiness and potential. While the assessment structure is the same across all levels, we provide additional support for language development in Years 7 to 9 to ensure a smooth transition into the senior school environment.

For students entering Year 10, who are beginning their IGCSE journey, we pay close attention to academic fit and motivation. Sixth Form applicants to join Year 12 are evaluated based on a combination of academic performance, subject readiness and personal character.

Admissions Process

- **Application:** Families submit academic records, school reports and a profile of the child's interests and achievements
- **Assessment:** All applicants take our Entrance Test, which includes a computerised baseline assessment, an English proficiency test and a short written essay
- **Engagement:** Shortlisted students are invited for an interview with the Head of Prep or relevant Heads of Key Stage and encouraged to visit the College to experience school life firsthand

KEY ENTRY POINTS

Year 4 to Year 6

We look for children who are curious, enthusiastic and ready to grow. These years lay the foundation for confidence and academic independence.

Year 7 to Year 9

A critical transition into Senior School. Students at this stage benefit from a strong academic structure and language support where needed, as they build the foundations for future study.

Year 10

As students begin their IGCSE programme, we seek learners who are academically prepared and motivated. A clear sense of direction and readiness for more rigorous study is key.

Year 12 (Sixth Form)
